

EMPLOYMENT RECRUITMENT FRAUD ALERT

Please be advised that we are aware of attempted fraudulent recruitment activities by third parties, including requests for banking, credit and other personal information by individuals or organizations claiming to recruit by or on behalf of prospective employers. The fraudulent activities have typically started with bogus job interview inquiries or unsolicited applications sent by email, instant messenger, texts or similar electronic means. Lifestar Pharma DOES NOT request that its employees or prospective employees provide payment or personal bank information as part of its recruitment process, and does not conduct employment interviews via any social media platform, Google Hangouts, Yahoo! Messenger, text message, or e-mail. Unfortunately, employment scams are increasingly common and it is important to remain vigilant when conducting a job search. If you are contacted by an authorized Lifestar Pharma representative regarding a job opportunity, there should be no cost to you as the job seeker and Lifestar Pharma never asks for money or deposits to attend any interviews or in connection with any job opening. If you believe that you are or may be the target of fraudulent recruiting activities and/or are asked to pay money or for personal financial or security information, **DO NOT REPLY** and then you should contact local law enforcement.
